ADMISSION POLICY OF THE SCHOOL 2021-2022

St. Teresa's Little Kingdom School is a Private Unaided Minority Institute, registered under the Article 30 (1) of the Constitution of India. The managing body of the School is a Trust, Constituted by the Sisters belonging to the Congregation of Mother of Carmel, which is engaged in Charitable and Educational activities all over India and abroad. Thus the School Management reserves to itself the right to admit or refuse the admission forms as per the rules and regulations set up by the School Management.

I. Admission Procedure

- 1) Age Criteria:-The child should complete his/her age of 2.6 (2 ½) years on or before 31st May'2021.
- 2) No recommendation and donation will be entertained for admission. The management has not entrusted any individual or group to accept donation on behalf of School.
- 3) In all matters related to admission, the management's decision is final.
- 4) We do not issue admission forms to any other grade, since there is no vacancy.

II. Documents to be submitted at the time of Document verification.

- 1) Attested Copy of Birth Certificate (Obtained from the Municipal Corporation / Nagar Parishad/Panchayat)
- 2) Attested Copy of Caste Certificate of the parent/Leaving Certificate of Parents.
- 3) Stamp size Photograph to be affixed on the application form. Family photo max. Width 10 cm
- 4) Identity Proof of both Parents – Aadhar Card / Voter Identity Card.
- 5) Xerox copy of Aadhar Card /enrollment receipt of the Child. (If available)
- 6) A printout of the online application receipt has to be submitted.
- 7) Pan card of father. Or mother
- 8) Address Proof of Parent: -- (Any two as per the below list)
 - a) Ration Card issued in the name of the parent.
 - b) Voter Identity Card/Driving License/Passport issued in the name of one of the parents .
 - c) Aadhar Card/UID Card issued in the name of one of the parents
 - d) Electricity Bill/MTNL Telephone Bill/Water Bill in the name of either parent
 - e) Sale Agreement [only 1st and last page] /Rent agreement signed in the last six months .
- 9) Along with above stated documents, additional documents asked as per the different criteria mentioned below should be submitted in a hard copy placed in a file.

III. Admission Criteria

The admission criteria for the year 2021-2022 is as follows :-

- 1) General Quota (35%) - Open to all.
- 2) Local Quota (12.5%) - Children who are residing within one kilometer radius of the School.
- 3) Management quota (12.5%) – Reserved
- 4) Siblings Quota (25%) - Candidates who are siblings of students studying in the school from same parent.
- 5) Government employee Transfer Quota (2.5%) - Candidates who are children of the Army / Police / CRPF personal and in Government service (2.5% only)
- 6) Community Quota (5%) - Candidates who are Catholic / Christians.
- 7) Ex-students quota (2.5%)- Candidate whose parent is an ex-student of the same school.

IV .Admissions are reserved in the following ways:
